Ann ROGERS was born in 1799, in Halam, Nottinghamshire. Halam is about 20km north-east of Nottingham. Her parents were William ROGERS, a farmer, and Zipporah BAILEY. I wonder where the name 'Zipporah' came from? Ann married Joseph MUSSON in 1822, in Grantham Lincolnshire. Neither of this couple grew up near Grantham, so they probably met while working there. Together, they had seven children by 1839, but sadly, Ann died a few years later, in 1848, in Grantham. Her widower husband then decided to bring the family to South Australia, arriving here in 1854 on the ship 'Emigrant'. Anne's ancestors are somewhat elusive, but they involve the name William.

Origin of the Surname ROGERS

English (of Norman origin): variant of Roger, with genitival or post-medieval excrescent -s.

William ROGERS b c1750

The earliest ancestor I can find records for is William ROGERS, born about 1750. I only know of him through the baptism records of his children, of which there were six recorded. Our line continues through the eldest, William, born in 1771, in Nottingham.

William ROGERS b1771

William ROGERS was born in 1771, in Nottingham, Nottinghamshire. He married Zipporah BAILEY in 1794, in Halam Nottingham. They had five children, the fourth of which was Ann ROGERS, born in 1799, in Halam.

Ann ROGERS b1799-1848

Ann was born in 1799 in Halam Nottingham. Halam is about 20 km north-east of Nottingham, and a very small village at this time. Ann married Joseph MUSSON in 1822, in Grantham Lincolnshire. Grantham is around 30km south-east of Halam. Ann and Joseph had seven children, the third being Richard MUSSON, born in 1829 in Grantham. Ann died in 1848 in Grantham, at the young age of 49 years. Joseph, as a widower, brought their children to South Australia in 1854, to presumably start a new life in Adelaide. Joseph was a boatman in England, and died in North Adelaide in 1869, aged 73 years, so probably died a gentleman.

Ann ROGERS is Jan SQUIRE's great x 3 grandmother. Their great granddaughter married my mother's father, Edwin RUNDLE, my grandfather and my mother's maiden name.
