

Duncan BUCHANAN 1819 – 1890

Duncan BUCHANAN was the only one of our South Australian pioneers to have spent several years in another continent before emigrating to Australia. He was born in Glendaruel, Scotland in 1819, and went to Argentina at the age of about 22 years. Duncan worked in pastoral pursuits for 14 years before returning to Scotland. He became a very skilled horseman, but he left Argentina and returned home, due to poor conditions in Argentina for non-locals. Still unmarried, but disliking the Scottish climate, he emigrated to South Australia, settling immediately in Mt Gambier. Duncan was a real adventurer and a skilled horseman when he arrived at the Mount. After working for Mr Neil BLACK for two years, he bought a farm at Square Mile, a few miles south-east of Mount Gambier, where he farmed for the rest of his life. Duncan died in 1890.

We know Duncan's parents were John BUCHANAN and Janet WEIR, and they were married in 1803, in Strathblane. There are too many births in the relevant time period to be sure exactly where and when Duncan and Janet were born. Duncan was born in 1819 on the west of Scotland, close to the Isle of Mull, in Argyllshire. He had two brothers that I can find, Dugald, born in 1818, and Charles, born 1821.

We have a substantial obituary of Duncan's life from the Mt Gambier and Adelaide press, which gives details of his early life. In Argentina, he worked around the Buenos Aires area, and acquired exceptional horsemanship skills. He also lost an eye at some point. Duncan left Argentina because of the unfavourable laws of the country, and he returned to Scotland. After about a year, he left Scotland again, bound for Australia and most likely arrived in Portland, Victoria. He then travelled overland to Mt Gambier. He worked as a stockman for two years for Mr Neil BLACK, before taking up farming at Square Mile, South-East of Mt Gambier.

Duncan married Christina McARTHUR in 1857. She was almost 20 years younger than Duncan, and they went on to have ten children, five boys and five girls. Their second child and eldest daughter, Flora BUCHANAN was born in 1860. On Duncan's death in 1890, Christina built a new house on Bay Road, Mt Gambier, and moved there with the girls. The boys stayed on the farm, and they ran their substantial abattoir on the property for many years.

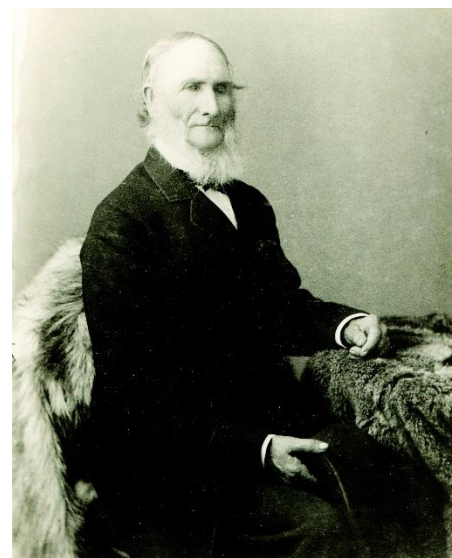


Fig 3 Christina BUCANAN, and three daughters, four sons.
