Eliza STEWART is another of my new and very short narratives, and the records are somewhat sparse. Eliza is the daughter of a Presbyterian minister, so she probably moved around a bit in her youth. She was born in 1821 in Walsingham, Norfolk, and married Samuel KEIGHTLEY in 1842 in Loughborough, Leicestershire. In 1850, Eliza, Samuel and their first four children embarked on their journey to South Australia. Eliza had another five children in Adelaide, so it ended up being a large family of nine children. Eliza died in 1895 in the city of Adelaide, at the age of seventy three years.

STEWART Surname

Scottish (Lanarkshire) and English: originally an occupational name for an administrative official of an estate, from Middle English stiward, Old English stigweard, stīweard, a compound of stig 'house(hold)' + weard 'guardian'. In the Anglo-Saxon period this title was used of an officer controlling the domestic affairs of a household, especially of the royal household; after the Norman Conquest it was also used more widely as the native equivalent of Seneschal, for the steward of a manor or manager of an estate. In Scotland the term was also used of a magistrate originally appointed by the king to administer crown lands, forming a stewartry. (from FamilySearch website)

Ebenezer STEWART b1791

Eliza's father was Ebenezer STEWART, born in 1791 according to his burial record. I cannot find any record of his baptism or birth in this year, but there are a few in 1788. However, a baptism in 1791 is consistent with Ebeneser's age at death. Ebenezer married Lucy WILSON in 1817 in Hundleby, Lincolnshire. Ebenezer and Lucy had seven children, the third being Eliza, born in 1821, in Walsingham, Norfolk. Ebenezer was a Presbyterian minister, so he moved around a bit with his family. He only spent 20 years as a minister before dying at the young age of 40 years, in 1832, in Doncaster, Yorkshire.



Ebenezer married at the place marked 1, and died at 2.

Eliza STEWART b1821

Eliza STEWART was born in 1821 in Walsingham, Norfolk, which would have been in her father's parish at that time. According to various newspaper articles and notices, the family were in Loughborough for a time, which is where the KEIGHTLEY family lived. Eliza must have got to know Samuel KEIGHTLEY well, for they married in 1842, in Loughborough. This was well after her father died though. Eight years later, Samuel, Eliza and the family of four children were on a ship heading to South Australia. Once in Adelaide, they settled in Angaston and had another five children. Eliza died in 1895, in Adelaide.
