Elizabeth ROBINS was born in 1785, in St Blazey, Cornwall, which is about 4km east of St Austell, and 2km from the site of the Eden project. Her father was William ROBINS, but I cannot be sure where he was born. He most likely worked in the nearby mines or open cut quarries as a labourer. The quarries extracted china clay that was highly prized and used widely, and this was the main industry and employer in the area. Elizabeth married Joseph RUNDLE in 1814, in St Blazey. They had seven children, the third being William RUNDLE, who later married Caroline GEORGE and they emigrated to South Australia in 1854. Elizabeth died in 1832 in St Blazey.

## **Origin of the Surname ROBINS**

English: from the personal name Robin, with genitival or post-medieval excrescent -s.

### William ROBINS b c1760

William ROBINS was born about 1760, in or near St Austell, Cornwall. I cannot be sure of an exact location because there are records for several possibilities. We know he married Elizabeth RUNDLE in 1780 in St Blazey, Cornwall. They had at least one child, Elizabeth, born in 1785. In the 1851 census, he is listed as a mine labourer, but ten years later, the census records him as an elderly farm labourer. William ROBINS was a somewhat common name, so am not sure which death/burial record might be his.

## Elizabeth ROBINS b1785

We have better luck with records for Elizabeth. She was born in 1785, in St Blazey, Cornwall. In 1814, she married Joseph RUNDLE in St Blazey, and subsequently had seven children. The third was William RUNDLE, born in 1819. He married Caroline GEORGE, and they came to South Australia. Elizabeth died in 1832, still in St Blazey, at the fairly young age of 47 years.

Elizabeth is Jan SQUIRE's great x 4 grandmother, and she married Joseph RUNDLE, my mother's maiden name.
