Elizabeth SCADDING 1779 – 1857

Elizabeth SCADDING was born in 1779 in Farway, Devon. I can only write about her from distant records that I have found. Farway is a tiny village in the south-east part of Devon, around 6km south-east of Honiton. The church is at least from the 13th century but has been rebuilt or altered since then. The village was also dominated by the former manor owned by the PRIDEAUX family. Elizabeth met John SQUIRE (born 1773), and they married in Clyst St. Lawrence in 1801. John was a farm labourer, like so many others of this time. Clyst St. Lawrence is some ten km west of Farway, but still in a remote part of Devon, and was and is undulating farmland. They soon moved to Wiveliscombe where one child was born. Their second son, Isaac, was born in Upton, a bit to the west of Wiveliscombe. Elizabeth died in 1857 in Wiveliscombe, and is buried there.

Origin of the Surname SCADDING

English: unexplained. Possibly linked with SW English dialect words scad meaning 'salmon fry' and 'peat slab', in either case in an old regional plural form in -en, but no certainty is possible.

John SCADDING b c1755

I can only be sure about Elizabeth's father, John SCADDING, who was mentioned on Elizabeth's baptism record. He married Mary by 1778, probably in Farway, Devon, but I cannot find any evidence.

Farway (Devon) is at '1', and Clyst St. Lawrence is at '2'.



Elizabeth SCADDING b 1779

Elizabeth was born in 1779 in Farway, east Devon, which is about five km south of Honiton in Devon. Farway is now a tiny village, but does have a few houses and businesses still in existence. Elizabeth met and married John SQUIRE in 1801. They married in Clyst St. Lawrence, Devon. John was probably an agricultural labourer.
