Frances LEE was born in 1798 in Lincoln, Lincolnshire, England, to Samuel LEE and Mary BONNER. Samuel and Mary both grew up in Lincoln, but they married in Grantham, some 35km to the south-west of Lincoln. Samuel and Mary LEE lived here for the rest of their lives, and they brought six children into this world. We are interested in their fifth child, Frances, who eventually married George PRIEST, had six children in Grantham, and then sailed to South Australia on the ship 'Omega', in 1851, along with quite a few other PRIEST family members. Frances and George settled in North Adelaide, where George worked for a time as a mason and builder. Frances died in 1893, at the wonderful age of 95 years. George lived well too, being 85 years at his death in 1889.

Origin of the Surname LEE

English: topographic name for someone who lived near a meadow or a patch of arable land, Middle English *lee*, *lea*, from Old English *lēa*, dative case (used after a preposition) of *lēah*, which originally meant 'wood or glade'. also: habitational name from any of the many places in England named with Old English *lēah* 'wood, glade', including Lee in Buckinghamshire, Essex, Hampshire, Kent, and Shropshire, and Lea in Cheshire, Derbyshire, Herefordshire, Lancashire, Lincolnshire, and Wiltshire.

Samuel LEE b c1725

I have found records to identify Frances' grandfather Samuel LEE, born around 1725 in Lincoln. His name is only recorded on his son's baptism record, but I found his marriage record, to Elisabeth HAMMOND in 1747. I am not certain how many children they had, but their son Samuel LEE was born in 1757 in Lincoln, at the Church of St Margaret's in the Close. I found that 'The Close' is a street near the centre of Lincoln. I cannot find a record of Samuel's death in or near Lincoln.

Samuel LEE b1757

Samuel LEE (junior!!) was born in 1757 in Lincoln, to Samuel and Elisabeth. Samuel (junior) married Mary BONNER, also from Lincoln, in 1784. They had six children, the fifth being Frances LEE, born in 1798, still in Lincoln.

Frances LEE b1798

Frances LEE was born in 1798, in Lincoln, to Samuel and Mary. Frances married George PRIEST in 1824, in Grantham, around 25 km south-east of Lincoln. I cannot find out why they moved, but possibly it related to George's apprenticeship as a mason, or work as a builder. They are recorded in the 1841 and 1851 census's as being at various addresses in Grantham, but within a few weeks of the 1851 census, they were on the ship 'Omega', bound for South Australia. Frances and George were close to 50 years of age at this time, with their eldest 'child' nearing 30 years. The youngest, however, was only eight years of age. They arrived in Adelaide in July 1851, and immediately settled in North Adelaide. Frances died in 1893, and she is buried at the Walkerville cemetery.

Frances LEE is Jan SQUIRE's great x 3 grandmother. Their great granddaughter married my mother's father, Edwin RUNDLE, my grandfather, and my mother's maiden name.
