Hannah TOTHILL c1790 – ?

Hannah TOTHILL was one of several women who married into the Scottish STODART family, which we have traced back to the mid 1400's. Hannah was born in 1790, in London, Middlesex, and the TOTHILL family was a long-time adherent in the Quaker faith. She married John STODART in 1814 in St James Anglican church, Middlesex. John is important because he was one of a few STODART men making and selling the STODART piano. Robert started the STODART Piano Company around 1775, and John was involved from the early 1800's. He and Hannah moved to New York in the 1820's, and they set up the New York piano business. The Company sold pianos for many years, but John died in 1834. Their fourth child, John, stayed in England and came to Melbourne Australia, with his wife and five children, in 1852.

Anne and myself saw and touched an early STODART piano in a Buenos Aires museum in 2017.

Origin of the Surname TOTHILL

English: (i) locative name from various places named with Old English * *tot-hyll* 'lookout hill', primarily Toothill in Rastrick (WR Yorks) and perhaps Tootle in Longridge (Lancs), but also Tuttle Hill in Nuneaton (Warwicks), and Tothill (Lincs). There are several further minor place-names of this type that may have contributed to the surname. (ii) locative name, occasionally from Tottenhill (Norfolk), recorded as *Totehill* in 1251.

Thomas TOTHILL b?

We do not know much about Thomas, except what is recorded on his son's baptism record. We know the family were Quakers (Society of Friends) when he married Sarah WHITE in 1754 in London. Their son William was born in Devonshire House, the London (Piccadilly) home of the Dukes of Devonshire, although the building was demolished in the early 1900's.

William TOTHILL b1760

William TOTHILL was born in 1760, in Devonshire House, just outside of the northern corner of Green Park, north of Buckingham Palace. He married Sarah WARING in 1782, in the Quaker faith in Guildford, Surrey, to the south west of London. They had eight children, the sixth being Hannah TOTHILL, born in 1790, and the subject of this narrative.

Hannah TOTHILL b1790

Hannah TOTHILL was born in 1790, in the Society of Friends' (Quaker) meeting house in London. She married John STODART in 1814, in the Church of England parish of St James, Westminster. John was born in Scotland, near Edinburgh, so he must have come to London to learn the piano business, and met Hannah. We do not know the consequences for Hannah of marrying an Anglican, but it is possible she left for America with John to avoid any repercussions. They would have emigrated in the 1820's but I cannot find any evidence to confirm this. John and his brother Adam, with families, went to America, and were successful in setting up their piano business in New York. I believe the business closed in the early 1900's, so it operated for several generations. John STODART died in 1834, so Hannah probably outlived him.

Only some of their children went to America with John and Hannah, and notably, John's second son and fourth child, also John, married and came to Melbourne, Victoria with his family.

Hannah TOTHILL is Anne SQUIRE's great x 3 grandmother. Her son John STODART, was Anne's great x 2 grandfather, and he came to Victoria Australia, with his wife and family.
