

# Joseph MUSSON 1796- 1869

Joseph MUSSON was born and grew up in the village of Long Clawson, south east of Nottingham, England, but in his teens he moved to Grantham in Lincolnshire where he worked as a Boatman and Carrier. Here, Joseph met and married Ann ROGERS in 1822. They spent 26 years of married life together, and they had seven children. When Ann died in 1848, the family discussed a move to South Australia and Adelaide, even though Joseph was already 50 years old. From here, the MUSSON name is entwined with the PRIEST family. Joseph's son Richard MUSSON married Frances PRIEST in Grantham, and daughter Frances MUSSON married John PRIEST after they arrived in Adelaide. Richard and Frances emigrated first in 1851 on the ship 'Omega', with most of the PRIEST family. Then daughter Ann came to Melbourne in 1854 (on the 'Ontario'), and our Joseph came to Adelaide, with the rest of his children, also in 1854, aboard the ship 'Emigrant'.

Joseph's grandfather was almost certainly Joseph MUSSON of Long Clawson, where he married Mary CAMPION in 1761. I say 'almost', because if this is correct, their first three children were born before marriage. It is possible they married previously in a non-conformist church, but later decided they needed or wanted a Church of England marriage for legal or other reasons. We can identify six children of this couple from the parish records, the eldest being another Joseph, born and baptised in 1757, still in Long Clawson.

This Joseph MUSSON was born in Long Clawson in 1763, and married Mary HOLMES in 1792. They had eight children in Long Clawson. The second child and first son of this Joseph and Mary HOLMES was yet another Joseph, born in 1796. This is the Joseph of this narrative, but he moved to Grantham, probably in his teens, and worked as a boatman and carrier, and must have been well educated. He married Ann ROGERS in 1822 in Grantham. They attended the Primitive Methodist Chapel in Commercial Road, Grantham, where Joseph is recorded as the Treasurer. Ann died in 1848, of Typhus Fever, and this is most likely the trigger for the family to consider emigration.

Joseph and Ann had seven children by 1839, all born in Grantham, and the third child, Richard, was born in 1829. Richard married Fanny PRIEST in 1849, starting the close connection to the PRIEST family. Richard and Fanny MUSSON left for Adelaide in 1851, with the PRIEST family. Richard must have sent back good reports, because the rest of the MUSSON's followed within a few years. Richard's published obituary tells us he worked around the Port, except for a short period when he travelled to the gold diggings at Bendigo to try for a fortune. We suspect that the fortune did not eventuate, for he returned to Adelaide to work for J HART and Co, later becoming the Adelaide Milling Company. These were one of the State's biggest and best flour millers of the time. The mill buildings still appear to be standing on the bank of Port Creek, west of the town centre.

Richard and Fanny MUSSON had eight children, mostly born in North Adelaide, but around 1864, they had moved to the Port Adelaide area where their last two children were born. Their sixth child was Fanny MUSSON, born in 1862. She married John Albert RANN in 1889, at Port Adelaide. I have written about the RANN family previously, and their narratives lead from the RANN family to RUNDLE then to SQUIRE. John and Fanny RANN are Jan SQUIRE's great grandparents. Joseph MUSSON is Jan's great great grandfather.
