

Lucy WILSON 1791 – ?

We do not know much about Lucy. She was born in 1791 in Grantham, Lincolnshire, and married Ebenezer STEWART in Hundleby, Lincolnshire in 1817. Ebenezer was an Anglican and later a Methodist minister, so they would have been moving around, and living in manses for most of their time together. Lucy was a widow by the time of the 1841 census, but she is recorded as having independent means. The census record shows she had four children at home, plus both her mother and mother-in-law living with them. I am not certain when Lucy died, but her third child, Eliza STEWART, had married Samuel KEIGHTLEY in 1841, and Samuel and Eliza came to South Australia (with four children) in 1850.

Origin of the Surname WILSON

English: from the Middle English personal name Will + patronymic *-son* 'son of *Will*'. *Will* was a very common medieval short form of William . This surname is also very common among African Americans.

Edward WILSON b c1760

Lucy's father, Edward WILSON, was born around 1760, in or near Grantham, Lincolnshire. He married Sarah WETHERALL in 1785, in Grantham, Lincolnshire.

Lucy WILSON b1790

Lucy was born in 1790 in Grantham, and married Ebenezer STEWART in 1817, in Hundleby, Lincolnshire. Ebenezer was an Anglican and later a Methodist minister, so they probably moved around a bit. He died in 1832, at the age of 41 years, so quite young, but Lucy is recorded as having independent means in the 1841 census. It seems likely that the church was looking after its widows.

Lucy WILSON is Anne SQUIRE's great x 3 grandmother. Sally's daughter was Anne's great x 2 grandmother Eliza STEWART, who married Samuel KEIGHTLEY.
